The purpose of this letter is to request additional comments from you on the draft Programmatic Agreement (PA) for the above referenced undertaking under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and 36 C.F.R. Part 800. As you know, the Surface Transportation Board's Office of Environmental Analysis (OEA) developed the draft PA through a series of consulting party meetings and teleconferences from February 2014 through January 2015. You and the others included in the PA Working Group incorporated those comments into the attached draft PA. (Also attached are your May 6, 2015 comments; we will incorporate these with any further suggested changes you may have.)

The attached draft PA is the identical version included as an appendix to the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). We request your comments on the attached draft PA by September 23, 2015 to coincide with the close of the Draft EIS comment period. After the comment period closes, OEA plans to revise the PA, redistribute it to the consulting parties, continue consultation, and begin to seek signatures. We are in the process of developing a timeline that will include firm dates for the PA development and completion process.
